## Abbreviations (US terms)

mr: magic ring

ss: slip stitch

sc: single crochet

ch: chain stitch

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

inc: increase (2 sc in same stitch)

dec: decrease (2 sc crocheted together)

\*\* x (followed by a number) repeat from \* to \* the amount of times stated



## Materials

- 100% cotton yarn 8/4
  - Grey ≈ 40 g
  - Natural ≈ 15 g
  - A little black
  - A little white
- Fibre filling
- Hook size 2.5 mm
- Needle for sewing and scissors
- Stitch markers

# The Head

- The head is worked in continuous rounds without joins, the use of a stitch marker at beginning of rounds will help to keep track of sts.

- *Using Grey*

- Work a magic ring

Rnd 1: Sc6 in mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*inc\* x6 (12)

Rnd 3: \*sc1, inc\* x6 (18)

Rnd 4: \*sc2, inc\* x6 (24)


Rnd 5: \*sc3, inc\* x6 (30)

Rnd 6: sc in each st around (30)

Rnd 7: \*sc4, inc\* x6 (36)

Rnd 8: \*sc5, inc\* x6 (42)

- To mark where nostrils will be place stitch markers (or a strand of yarn) in 9<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> st of last round, making sure they are on the outside of the head



Rnd 9: \*sc6, inc\* x6 (48)

Rnd 10: \*sc7, inc\* x6 (54)

Rnds 11-16: sc in each st around (54) (6 rnds)

Rnd 17: \*sc7, dec\* x6 (48)

Rnd 18: sc in each st around (48)

Rnd 19: \*sc6, dec\* x6 (42)

Rnd 20: sc in each st around (42)

Rnd 21: \*sc5, dec\* x6 (36)

Rnd 22: \*sc4, dec\* x6 (30)

Rnd 23: sc in each st around (30)

Rnd 24: \*sc9, inc\* x3 (33)

Rnd 25: \*sc10, inc\* x3 (36)

Rnd 26: \*sc11, inc\* x3 (39)

Rnds 27-29: sc in each st around (39) (3 rnds)

- Start to add stuffing and continue adding more as you work

Rnd 30: \*sc11, dec\* x3 (36)



Rnd 31: \*sc4, dec\* x6 (30)

Rnd 32: \*sc3, dec\* x6 (24)

Rnd 33: \*sc2, dec\* x6 (18)

Rnd 34: \*sc1, dec\* x6 (12)

- Add more stuffing before closing the head

Rnd 35: dec x6 (6)

- Fasten off leaving a tail.

- Close by threading tail through the front loops of the sc6 from last round. When you pull the yarn, the hole will close like it does when you use a magic ring. Secure ends.

### **Nostrils:**

- Thread a needle with grey yarn. Insert the needle into the underside of the back of the head (where the body will be mounted) push the needle through the head to one of the stitch markers, come out to the left of the marked sc go over it and back through to the back to where you started. Cut yarn leaving a tail, you will have 2 threads hanging down. Using another piece of yarn repeat for the other nostril, going through and over the other marked stitch. You will now have 4 threads out of the back of the head, remove markers. Pull on the threads to make an indent for each nostril. To keep the nostrils in place, tie the threads in a knot. Even if the knot is visible now, it will be invisible once the body has been attached.
