## Abbreviations (US terms)

mr: magic ring

ss: slip stitch

sc: single crochet

ch: chain stitch

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

inc: increase (2 sc in same stitch)

dec: decrease (2 sc crocheted together)

\*\* x (followed by a number) repeat from \* to \* the amount of times stated



## Materials

- 100% cotton yarn 8/4
  - Grey ≈ 40 g
  - Natural ≈ 15 g
  - A little black
  - A little white
- Fibre filling
- Hook size 2.5 mm
- Needle for sewing and scissors
- Stitch markers

## Eyes x2

- The use of a stitch marker at beginning of rounds will help to keep track of sts.

- *Begin with Black*

- Work a magic ring

Rnd 1: sc6 in mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*inc\* x6 (12)

- *Fasten of black*

- *Using white. Start with a standing sc.*

Rnd 3: \*sc1, inc\* x6 (18)

- Join with a ss into next sc, fasten off leaving a tail for sewing onto head.

### Hint:

With white yarn, you may wish to make a small "v" in the black of the eye thereby creating a neat effect like this: sew through mr, into two separate sc.



## Large Horn

- Using natural

- Work a magic ring.

Rnd 1: sc6 in mr (6)

Rnd 2: sc1 in each st around (6)

Rnd 3: inc, sc4, inc (8)

Rnd 4: sc1 in each st around (8)

Rnd 5: inc, sc6, inc (10)

Rnd 6: sc1 in each st around (10)

Rnd 7: inc, sc8, inc (12)

Rnd 8: sc1 in each st around (12)

Rnd 9: inc, sc10, inc (14)

Rnd 10: sc1 in each st around (14)

Rnd 11: inc, sc12, inc (16)

Rnd 12: inc, sc14, inc (18)

Rnd 13: inc, sc16, inc (20)

Rnd 14: sc1 in each st around (20)

- Join with a ss to the next sc, fasten off leaving a tail for sewing onto the head. Stuff the horn tightly.

## Small Horn

- Using natural

- Work a magic ring.

Rnd 1: sc6 in mr (6)

Rnd 2: sc1 in each st around (6)

Rnd 3: inc, sc4, inc (8)

Rnd 4: sc1 in each st around (8)

Rnd 5: inc, sc6, inc (10)

Rnd 6: sc1 in each st around (10)

Rnd 7: inc, sc8, inc (12)

Rnd 8: inc, sc10, inc (14)

Rnd 9: inc, sc12, inc (16)

Rnd 10: sc1 in each st around (16)

- Join with a ss to the next sc, fasten off leaving a tail for sewing onto the head. Stuff the horn tightly.
